

Superintendent Arrives; Concordia Lutheran's New School Set To Open


First superintendent of Concordia Lutheran church's parochial school, which will open for the first time when public schools open next month, is Norman Hitzeman.

Hitzeman arrived from Fort Wayne, Indiana, on July 28. He and Mrs. Hitzeman are residing at 529 Olive court. He is a June graduate of Concordia Teachers college, River Forest. He holds a bachelor of science degree in education.

Previously operating just kindergarten facilities, in the absence of any kindergarten being offered by Harlem district public schools, Concordia this summer kicked off a million-dollar ten-year expansion program by building a \$130,000 school wing.

This school structure will accommodate kindergarten through sixth grade. It will open next month with classes only through Grade 4; 5th grade will be added in September 1962, 6th grade in September 1963.
